WATER RIGHTS SECURE

THE water rights in Owens River Valley, especially those of the upper part of the valley, are among the oldest and best in the State. The continuous appropriation and use of water for fully fifty years has given vested rights which are as perfect as water rights can be. The Valley has an average supply of overground water from the eternal snows of the Mountains and an inexhaustible supply of underground water. Our tracts own one-half inch of water per acre in the Bishop Creek Canal—the oldest water right in Owens Valley. Yearly maintenance fifteen cents per acre.
