### **The South Fork Of The Kern River**

Grant Airpark, 90 miles north of Mojave on U. S. Highways 6 and 395, is the gate to a wonderful Sportsland for you, only 20 minutes away via safe flights conducted by experienced commercial pilots. The South Fork of the Kern River winds through the meadows, with surrounding forestation so dense that these home waters of the Golden Trout are also adjacent to the natural habitat of deer and bear. The South Fork of the Kern River and many tributary streams make the Trout fishing a virtual Sportsman's paradise. Airstrips adjacent to the many meadows, streams, lakes and forests make this Fisherman's and Hunter's wonderland accessible for even the shortest vacation period, or week-end relaxation.

### **Monache Meadows**

You should place your Gold Star against the name "MONACHE MEADOWS." With an elevation of 8,000 feet, it is the largest of the accessible meadows. In this virgin mountain setting you may still be in touch with the outer world by Forest Telephone.

### **Equipment . . . Rates . . . Accommodations**

The AIRLIFT PACK STATION makes it possible for you to reach the most remote sections of this vast wilderness of unspoiled streams, meadows and forests. Nowhere in the Sierras can the scenery, trout fishing, deer and bear hunting be equalled. A trip that would ordinarily cost you several days of travel time can be condensed into a short, scenically beautiful 20 minute flight. Mr. and Mrs. John Herbert, new managers of the Monache Lodge and Airlift Pack Station, will see that you are flown swiftly and comfortably to unexcelled camp sites and will provide everything for your comfort and convenience. Mr. Harold Burdick, an expert guide and horseman, will arrange your pack trips to the various streams, lakes and meadows surrounding Monache Lodge. Airlift passengers are permitted 60 pounds of camping equipment each. Additional supplies may be flown into camp upon request when 4c per pound is charged. However, tent camps, including cots, coleman stoves and lanterns are available at moderate rates at Monache Meadows. For most beautiful scenic effects, flights should be scheduled early mornings (sunrise to 10:00 A.M.) and evenings (5:00 P.M. to sunset), which also permit fullest time for enjoying the



meadows and you will be picked up for return trip at your convenience.

Cabin accommodations and a small store of staple supplies are available at Monache Lodge, overlooking the Kern. Excellent family style meals are provided at camp headquarters. Campfire permits are available at Airlift Pack Station headquarters.

At Grant you will find excellent accommodations, should you arrive late and desire to stay overnight. The J. G. Motel, where you secure your tickets for Airlift Pack Station, offers a real rest, at moderate prices. Across the highway is Airflite Cafe where you can enjoy wonderful food while waiting. The base from which your Airlift plane will depart is next to the Union Oil Station, where your car will be cared for and stored, free of charge, until your return trip home.
