



ANDREWS CAMP is beautifully situated in a mountainous valley 8100 feet elevation and surrounded by a grove of aspen trees, green meadows and wild flowers.

The climate of Andrews Camp is delightful during the summer months

The high Sierra with its towering peaks, Mt. Tom and Mt. Humphrey, are viewed from the Camp.

Andrews Camp is centrally located on the south fork of Bishop Creek affording easy access to the stream and lake fishing in the North, Middle and South fork canyons of Bishop creek.

The road from Bishop leads west through farming country, then south-west past the Southern Sierra Power Plants, up the Bishop creek canyon into the very heart of the High Sierra. The Automobile Club of Southern California keeps the road well signed. The Forest Service and county supervisors maintain the road in good condition.

Those coming by train should buy their tickets via Southern Pacific to Lone Pine, where auto stage connects with Bishop. At Bishop auto stage maybe taken to Camp.

Free public camp grounds just out side of the camp.



FISHING AND OTHER AMUSEMENTS

Within a radius of six miles are many lakes and streams well stocked with Eastern Brook, Steelhead, Loch Leven and Rainbow. Golden trout are found in some of the high lakes

To those who like to rest and read, the quiet of Andrews Camp affords the best opportunity.

The Camp is restful and home-like where kindly service and good meals are the first consideration.

To those who like to walk and climb, the trails afford plenty of opportunity to explore the beauties of nature, without fear of wild animals, snakes or insects. There are no mosquitoes at Andrews Camp. No poison oak in this locality.

The camp-fire around which the ardent fishermen gather in the evening affords a cheerful opportunity for the exchange of "fish stories," while the ladies may gather indoors for a social game of bridge. The amusement hall with its pool table, piano and dance floor affords other amusements.



EQUIPMENT AND RATES
