

You'll Enjoy a High Sierra Pack Trip ♦ Independence Is the Gateway to 280 Lakes

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PASSES NEAR INDEPENDENCE

THERE are five principal passes out of Independence that we use in our daily pack travel. The main pass is Kearsarge, which leads into Bubbs Creek, noted for its stream fishing, and the Kings River country with its many side trails to numerous lakes and streams, including: Rae Lakes, Sixty Lake Basin and Dragon Lake. Here you may catch the wily Rainbow, Steelhead and Lochleven running from pan size to six pounds or more.

East Lake and Reflection Lake are in a scenic setting under Mt. Brewer. In Reflection Lake Golden Trout abide alone, while in East Lake there are almost every known kind of trout. A foot trail leads to Harrison Pass where one may see a marvelous view of Kern River canyon.

Traveling down Bubbs Creek one comes to wonderful Kings River canyon, and from here we go into Sequoia and General Grant National Parks, Simpson and Dotherby Meadows, Paradise Valley and Woods Creek.

Over Sawmill Pass you reach Woods Lake, Twin Lake and Woods Creek, and Pinchot Pass which takes you to Bench Lake and headwaters of the South Fork of the Kings. Here you may go on over Partridge Pass and follow the Sierra Summit into Yosemite Valley.

Our Mt. Whitney trip is hard to equal, going over Shep-

herd's Pass into headwaters of the Kern River to South American Lake, then to Wallen Lake, Crabtree Meadow and out over the top of Mt. Whitney, highest peak in the United States, down through Whitney Portal, where we will meet you with your car or ours.

DRIVE TO INDEPENDENCE

INDEPENDENCE, which is on the main, through Three Flags Highway, U. S. 395, is the location of our main corrals. There is a good road leading to Kearsarge Valley at an elevation of 9000 feet, where we have another pack corral, starting point for pack trips over Kearsarge Pass.

We deliver stock at the foot of trails leading over other passes on the day before you start on your trip.

In Independence you will find good hotels and cafes, and stores where you may secure fresh supplies and fishing equipment at reasonable cost.

We also have nearby, Mt. Whitney Fish Hatchery, which is one of the largest and most beautiful hatcheries in the state.
