How to Reach Coso Hot Springs

To reach Coso by Railroad purchase your ticket over the Southern Pacific to Little Lake, Calif., via Mojave. Coso stage meets passengers at Little Lake, the fare being \$2.50 from the station to the springs, or \$5.00 round trip. Coso can also be easily reached by Automobile driving direct to Mojave from either the North or South and from Mojave to Coso over the Roosevelt Midland Trail, via Red Rock Canyon, which is the Main Branch of the Lincoln Highway South.

Places of Interest Near Coso

Coso Hot Springs has an altitude of 3,635 feet above sea level and is within twenty minutes by Automobile of the Pack Trail Entrance into the very heart of the Southern Sierras, which is a Paradise for the Hunter of Big Game and those who seek the Golden Trout. There are more Indian Hieroglyphics and sign writing within easy hiking distance of Coso than any other place in America. Within sight of the Hot Springs is Louisiana Peak, from whose summit on the West can be seen the top of Mount Whitney, the highest point in the United States, and on the Eastern side at the same time a view of the Bottom of Death Valley, which is the lowest point. These facts are unknown to the average tourist. More mountain peaks over 14,000 feet high in Inyo County than the whole of Switzerland.
