**A**LFA LFA occupies the first place among the industries and has never been equalled by any in which it has come in competition. Three cuttings, with a yield of seven tons to the acre being the average production.

On a 120 acre farm there was produced during one year:

1250.....	Sacks of Corn
572.....	" " Wheat
580.....	" " Barley
90.....	" " Oats
400.....	" " Potatoes
100.....	Tons " Hay

The growing community of Manzanar, 6 miles south of Independence, has orchards of Winesap apples that are ten years old. In year 1920 a two acre tract produced 9 tons; a seven acre tract 22 tons and a twelve acre tract 40 tons.

These apples sold for \$75.00 a ton on the ground; were placed in cold storage in Los Angeles, taken out in the late spring and topped the market thruout the season.

Two leading varieties took first prize at annual fruit exhibit at University of California.
