In addition to the J. G. MOTEL at Grant there are other facilities including a cafe, one of the finest service stations in the country, and an airfield.

Airborne Pack Station has been flying planes into the fishing and hunting areas of the High Sierras, and particularly Monache Meadows, since 1946. Over 2000 safe, comfortable flights have been made into this hunting and fishing paradise with three planes operating on busy week-ends. Within 20 minutes from Grant you can be in Monache Meadows by plane.



SPORTSMEN'S PARADISE



Few spots offer the sportsman so much as does Grant. Here the sportsman can fish or hunt. The PACIFIC FLY-WAY HUNTING CLUB at Grant offers good goose and duck hunting. Seven large shooting ponds with blinds to accommodate twenty-five hunters make this club a real hunters' paradise. It is open to the public. Rates: \$15.00 a day per hunter on Wednesdays, Saturdays, Sundays and holidays. In season, dove, quail and pheasant hunting can also be enjoyed.

MONACHE MEADOWS

Located 8000 feet in the heart of the High Sierras, Monache Meadows is the largest and most beautiful in all this area. It is the home of the Golden Trout, and the South Fork of the Kern River flows through its length. Here some of the finest fishing to be found anywhere can be enjoyed. During the season, deer and bear attract hardy hunters.

Rental cabins are available, and hunters can reach Monache Meadows either by Airborne Pack Station plane or by horseback from one of many pack stations in the area.
