

The Road to Follow

TO REACH PARCHERS RAINBOW CAMP from Los Angeles and Southern California take state highway through the San Fernando Valley to Palmdale, Lancaster and Mojave, thence north by way of Red Rock, Little Lake and Lone Pine to Bishop.

From Bishop take Bishop Creek road direct to camp.

The ordinary driving time from Los Angeles to Bishop is about eight hours. Driving time from Bishop to camp about an hour and a quarter.

From southern San Joaquin Valley cross the mountains by way of Walker's Pass and turn north to Bishop.

From upper San Joaquin Valley and Northern California cross by way of Tioga Pass, Sonora Pass or Lake Tahoe and turn south to Bishop.

Motor busses give daily service from Los Angeles to Bishop.

HOUSEKEEPING CABINS

Two Party Cabins, one or two persons,
one large double bed (per day) - \$ 2.50
By the week - - - - - \$15.00
Four Party Cabins, two large beds (day) \$ 4.00
By the week - - - - - \$25.00
Extra single cot, 75c per day.

The housekeeping cabins are completely furnished and equipped with bedding, linen, dishes, cooking utensils, etc.

SLEEPING CABINS

Single, by day - \$2.00 Double - \$2.50

DINING ROOM SERVICE

The camp maintains a dining room where excellent meals may be had at very reasonable prices.

STORE AND SERVICE STATION

The camp accommodations include a completely equipped store, where camp supplies, groceries, fishing tackle, fresh milk, butter, eggs, etc., may be secured.

Telephone and telegraph service, and a circulating library are among other conveniences of the camp.

The camp maintains its own electric light plant.

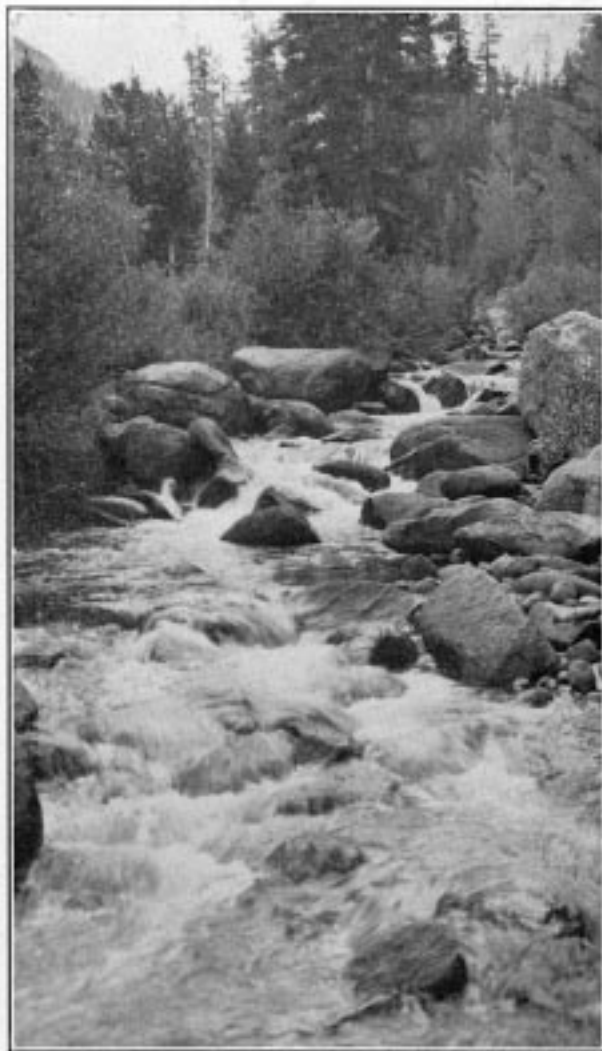
SADDLE AND PACK ANIMALS
