

Alluring Trails

ONE of the most delightful of the horseback trips starting from **PARCHERS RAINBOW CAMP** is over the **HIGH LAKES CIRCLE** which may be made in an easy day's ride. This trail, in its winding course through pines and meadows, passes fourteen crystal lakes and climbs to an altitude of over 11,000 feet. It is a trip never to be forgotten. The lakes visited on this trip are Weir, South, Hurd, Long, Bull, Chocolates (3), Ruwau, Saddle Rock, Timberline, and Spearhead.

Another fine trip is over the Green Lake trail to Baker Lakes and the Palisade Glacier on Big Pine Creek.

Over Bishop Pass

Parchers Rainbow Camp is the natural outfitting point for packing trips over Bishop Pass, elevation 11,988 feet, to the Dusey Lake Basin, the Middle Fork of the Kings, Palisade Creek, Grouse Meadows, Simpson Meadows and other points in the Kings River section. The river may be reached in a one day pack from the camp. Extraordinary golden trout fishing is to be had in the Dusey lakes and in the river.

A longer, and equally inspiring trip is along the Rainbow trail from Bishop Pass to Piute Pass by way of the Muir Trail. This trip takes you over the famous Muir Pass and through Evolution Basin to the South Fork of the San Joaquin and Piute Creek and over Piute Pass to the North Fork of Bishop Creek. Good trout fishing is to be had all along the way. This takes from a week to ten days.
