Convict Lake is nestled below high, snowy peaks, which are mirrored in the smooth surface of this famous body of water. There are five different trout streams within a half hour's ride of the resort, one of which is Hot Creek, long known as one of the finest fishing creeks in this region, as well as the Owens River. Convict Lake has the added attraction of being full of gamey trout including Rainbow, and LochLeven. The several lakes on upper Convict Creek, including Lakes Dorothy, Mildred, Genevieve, Cloverleaf and Edith, are stocked with the beautiful and delicious Golden and Rainbow trout, from which many limits are taken each year. Summer camp accommodations are available at Lake Dorothy.
