



- Never pollutes the streams or lakes by any means. If no toilet facilities are provided, he emulates the cat by digging and burying.
- Does not destroy or remove Forest or Park Service trail signs or take short cuts on the trail (cutting switchbacks damages the trails and saves neither time or effort).
- Obeys Forest Service or National Park rules (Example: Pets, firearms are not permitted in the National Parks).

- Remembers that stock have right-of-way on the trail. Stands quietly off the trail until the stock has passed.
- Clears the ground of any combustible material before building a fire, checking to see if the flames might ignite the branches above. NEVER leaves a fire unattended and when leaving extinguishes the fire—checking with the hand to be certain that no heat remains.
- Leaves his camp cleaner than he found it. Cuts the lids off his cans, burns and crushes them and packs them back out with him DOES NOT bury his cans and refuse.
