You can pack into the canyon proper and have these peaks as a backdrop for your camp or you can pack over McGee Pass into Upper Fish Creek. From any of the centrally located camps in Upper Fish Creek you can explore and fish the many lakes and their streams. Whichever you choose, you will find that you are in the primitive area where the fishing is unspoiled and the country is uncrowded.

You will find Golden, Rainbow, and Eastern Brook trout in the mountain streams and lakes. There is fishing to please the novice and to challenge the expert. Then in the fall you will find hunting and fly fishing at its best!

It's a wonderful world for children—even the younger ones ride well, catch fish and find things of interest never realized in the city.

There are four main types of pack trips—the SPOT TRIP, the ALL EXPENSE TRIP, the EXTENDED TRIP and the DUNNAGE PACK.

Spot Trip

On a Spot Trip you furnish all your own equipment and food—the pack outfit is just a means of transportation. We pack you in and leave you at a desirable campsite on a stream or lake. The packer and stock return to the pack station as you get organized for your stay. On longer spot trips, the packer will stay with you overnight, returning to his headquarters the following day. On a predetermined date, the packer will return to take you and your gear back. The spot trip is the most popular and most economical—as the only cost is transportation. The spot trip rate includes both in and out for you and your gear and your length of stay does not affect the total cost.*

**If pack load exceeds, 150 lbs. per person there is an additional charge of \$12.00 for each 150 lbs. or fraction thereof of added load.*

All Expense Trips

This is a favorite of the professional man and also of people being initiated into their first pack trip (many want to see how it's done). It's a carefree trip where food, cook, packer and all equipment are furnished with exception of personal gear and sleeping bag. The stock and packer are available for daily excursions or for a move to another campsite.

Write for rates, stating size of party and length of stay, as this will determine the total cost per day per person. For example: A party of 5 for 5 days or longer would cost \$48.00 each per day.

Extended or Continuous Trips

Traveling trips are especially popular with those who enjoy seeing new country. The stock and packer remain with you for the duration of your trip. You can choose to make a central camp and take daily trips, or you can plan to move camp every few days to another locale. Each party brings all their own equipment and provisions. Remember you have another mouth to feed—the packer's.
