Dunnage Packs

The Dunnage Pack is especially popular with confirmed hikers or large groups. It is an economical and ideal way to travel the High Sierra trails. The packer loads your gear on a mule and will leave it at a designated spot while you hike at your leisure. This arrangement can be made for your out trip or you can backpack out. The cost for 1 packer and 1 mule is \$45.00 per day. Each additional mule is \$12.00 per day with a limit of 5 mules per packer. Load limit is 150 lbs. per pack animal.
