PARADISE is at an elevation of 4800 feet, high enough for a rushing stream and towering pines, yet low enough for those who may not adjust comfortably to outer space. It is a most convenient stopping-off haven for travellers between Los Angeles and Reno . . . between Los Angeles and the Northwest.

Rushing Rock Creek, which flows by your modern and comfortable mountain cabin, is one of the Eastern High Sierra's most famous trout-fishing streams, its headwaters is at Rock Creek Lake. Nearby Round Valley is one of the Sierra's greatest deer hunting grounds, and for diversion from stream fishing there is famous Crowley Lake only a few minutes drive from PARADISE.
