

Drought Emergency To Affect Inyo Co.

Inyo and Mono counties definitely will be included in drought emergency edicts, Gov. Earl Warren disclosed in Sacramento this week.

Gov. Warren said he will proclaim the drought emergency in compliance with requests by California cattlemen, who are beset by a lack of livestock feed and a sharp rise in the price of hay

Its only immediate effect will be to aid cattlemen in obtaining lower freight rates for the transportation of feed and hay, he said, explaining that in view of the emergency, cattle growers may petition the Interstate Commerce Commission for the right to negotiate directly with railroads on rates.

Other implications of the "brown out" may include: conserving of electrical energy through. 1-Daylight saving time. 2-A "brown-out" of advertising signs, store windows and other electrical displays. 3-Rationing of power to industrial and domestic users.
