

Monday Last Day For Entries in Queen Contest

Monday is the last day entries may be filed with the Lone Pine Stampede committee to compete for the queen title, it was announced by Bruce Morgan and Tom Noland, who are handling the contest.

Entries must be turned in personally to either of these committeemen or postmarked April 23.

Seven candidates will vie in a stock horse contest a week from Sunday, April 29, as part of the elimination contest to select the queen. The contest will be held at the Stampede grounds, starting at 1:30 p.m.

There will be a donation of 50 cents for spectators of the prelude to the two-day Stampede a month from now.

The personality judging of the contestants will be held at the Lone Pine high school on Tuesday, May 1.

Queens of the Bishop, Las Vegas and Reno rodeos will be invited to attend the Stampede.

Tickets for the prizes to be given away on the last day of the Stampede are going well and a \$100 bonus will be given the organization doing the best selling job.

As an incentive to merchants in Lone Pine to decorate their windows in a theme in keeping with the celebration, cups for the two best decorated windows will be awarded by the committee.
