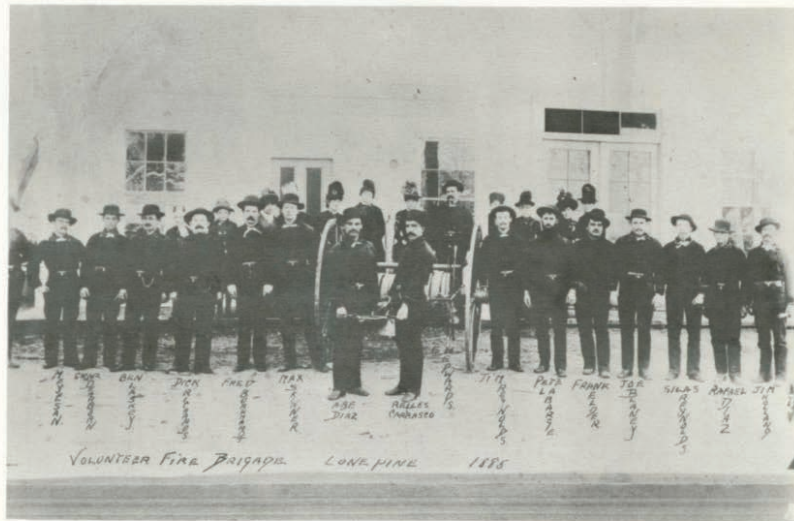

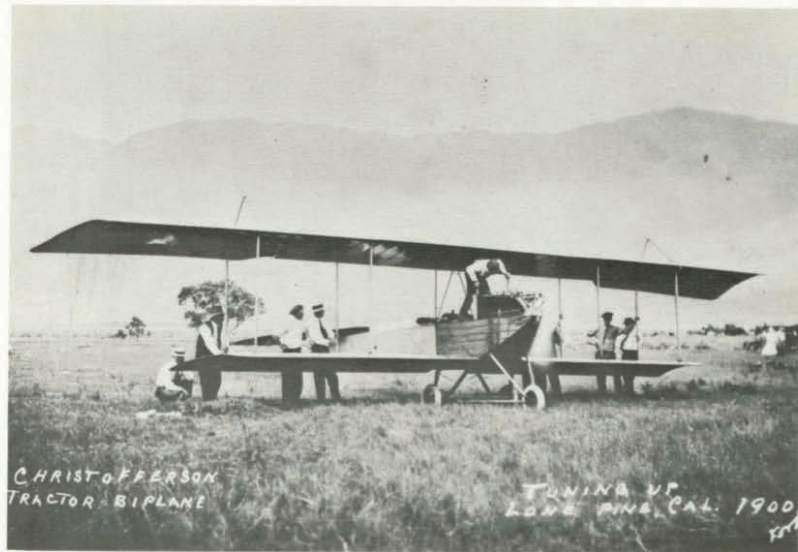

1. Freckles Brown.
