When the money's on the line in rodeo, judging is important to contestants and audience alike.

It's particularly sensitive—and sometimes controversial—in the three events where points awarded by judges determine who walks away with the cash.

Those events—bareback bronc riding, saddle bronc riding and bull riding—are scored by judges rating both the cowboy and animal on a point scale of 25. A judge scoring a contestant's perfect ride on a perfect bucking animal thus would give a score of 50... and who wouldn't like to see that?

When it comes to evaluating a man's ride a judge is equipped with his own opinion and the Rodeo Cowboys Association's rule book. His own personal experience is an important factor when it comes to deciding how hard the animal bucked.

Judges in the riding events also have responsibility for seeing that the riders observe such rules as spurring the horse out of the chutes, not touching the animal or rigging with the free hand, etc., but it's the scoring which really takes the skill.

The R.C.A. Board of Directors screens applicants for judging jobs at those rodeos which offer a thousand dollars or more per event. And, in an effort to improve and standardize the sport's judging, the R.C.A. has a judging school which uses such techniques as slow motion movies, enlarged illustrations and miniature models of chutes and barriers.

The rodeo judges also play an important part in such timed events as calf roping, steer wrestling, team roping and barrel racing but in these the scoring of a performance is less dependent upon the judge's personal opinion.
